
Click the blue button "Click here to download your eduroam installer

Click University of Verona (where the logo is also present)



If not found, search in the search bar "University of Verona"

Click on Eduroam. A software for installing eduroam certificates will be downloaded to the PC





Start the application by entering the required parameter username: gia@ateneo.univr.it and password gia.

Once the installation is complete, it will be possible to connect to eduroam.

MANUAL CONFIGURATION

The following instructions will enable you to connect your Android device to eduroam, the secure WiFi network.

Configuration instructions

- 1. Click "Settings" then select "Wireless & Networks" and "WiFi settings".
- 2. If WiFi is not enabled, please enable it.
- 3. Select "eduroam".
- 4. You may now be asked for a password to protect the credential storage on your device. This is a security setting for your device and not your WiFi password. Please enter a memorable password here to continue.
- 5. For "EAP method" select "PEAP".
- 6. For "Phase 2 authentication" select "MSCHAPV2".

- 7. Set "CA Certificate" to "Use system certificates" and "Domain" to "wifi.univr.it".
- 8. Enter your Identity as your username gia plus @ateneo.univr.it, e.g. "giauser@ateneo.univr.it".
- 9. Some devices may have an "Anonymous identity" field. Leave this blank.
- 10. Enter your WiFi password.
- 11. Touch "Connect".
- 12. Your device should show "Obtaining IP address from eduroam..." then shortly after "Connected to eduroam".
- 13. IMPORTANT: Press "Cancel" to go back to the previous screen. Do NOT press "Forget" or you will need to enter all the configuration information again. Your device should now connect automatically to the eduroam wireless network whenever it is in range.
